# ORGANIZATION OF THE PROFESSIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM

Those who attend the professional training courses at Opus Ballet follow a three-year program (2 years of training in the modern/contemporary department and 1 year of specialization in contemporary dance - R.O.S. Research Open Space which is accessed through selection) in which classes are conducted by high-profile teachers able to customize study to individual talent. The course schedules also allow students to regularly attend school or university.

#### **PROGRAM OF STUDIES**

#### - BALLET DEPARTMENT

Classical ballet technique, floor barre, pointe, pas de deux and classical repertoire, male technique, contemporary dance, modern

**EXAMINATIONS:** Every year an exam session is scheduled in April

**DIPLOMA:** Attendance certificates are issued

#### - DEPARTMENT OF MODERN/CONTEMPORARY DANCE

Classical dance technique, floor barre, modern, modern jazz, contemporary dance, choreographic workshops **EXAMINATIONS:** Two examination sessions are scheduled each year: in February and June. **DIPLOMA:** Attendance certificates are issued. A **final diploma** is issued at the end of the three-year period.

**OTHER ACTIVITIES:** during the three-year period many stage performances and events are organized in which the high level of technical preparation is recognized. The training course includes **CHOREOGRAPHICAL COMPOSITION AND PROJECTS** by the students. They are also helped to prepare for auditions and competitions
